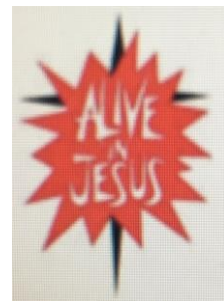

The Most Reverend Bishop Daniel R. Jenky, C.S.C. was ordained to the Priesthood in 1974. On February 12, 2002, His Holiness appointed Daniel R. Jenky, C.S.C. as the eighth Bishop of

Peoria, Illinois, and on April 10, 2002, he was installed in the Cathedral of Saint Mary. Since his installation, Bishop Jenky has traveled widely around the twenty-six counties of the Diocese, celebrating Mass, visiting parishes and schools, preaching, giving talks, and conferring the Sacrament of Confirmation.
