Mother Adela Galindo was born in Leon, Nicaragua. She considers the gift of the Blessed Mother's maternity in her life to be the most beautiful gift the Lord has given her. "My path is Marian...everything in my life has been a gift of Our Lady's Heart. My desire is to live and to die in the School of Mary's Heart".

During her youth, she became actively involved in the Charismatic Renewal, experiencing in a renewed manner the powerful effects of the union of two currents of spirituality, Marian and charismatic, which led her to a deep love for the Eucharistic Heart of Jesus. Mother Adela defines her life as based upon four pillars: profoundly Marian, Eucharistic centered, actively receiving and communicating the gifts of the Holy Spirit and in loving communion with the Heart of the Church and at her service.

In 1990, she founded the Religious Institute "Servants of the Pierced Hearts of Jesus and Mary" in the Archdiocese of Miami, Florida. The Sisters profess a Fourth Vow: "Total Marian Availability". The spiritual charism of the Institute is to be a living image and presence of the Heart of Mary in the Heart of the Church and in the heart of the world, and to place their Marian charism and the potentialities of their feminine genius in full communion and at the service of the Apostolic- Petrine Principle.



Author, worship leader, and speaker, Victoria Harris is committed to her mission: to train, equip and send Catholics to operate in the fullness of the gifts of the Holy Spirit for the building up of the Church. Harris' sophomore, independent record, Sweet Dolor, debuted at #2 on iTunes

Christian & Gospel charts, becoming one of the top 150 albums on all of iTunes during that time. Later, her interest in teaching others to operate in the gifts of the Holy Spirit, led her to found Arise Ministry and author her first book, Holy Spirit 101. The text is presently the only Catholic curriculum with ecclesial approval which trains the faithful to operate in the gifts of the Holy Spirit. An accomplished songwriter, her music has appeared alongside Hillsong & Aaron Shust in National Worship Leader Magazine's SongDISCOVERY disc, the 2015 OCP hymnal "Choose Christ", DayWind Record's Vital Worship: Dance of Joy, as well as the feature film, Hoovey. Her writing has also found it's home on a number of artist projects including musicians Brian Campbell, South x North and Alison Joy Williams. Harris currently resides with her husband and son in Dallas, Texas where she directs Arise Worship Ministry out of Mary Immaculate Catholic Church.
